Once you have mastered a skill, you teach it to someone else so that everyone can do better next time. You still do your best to win, just not at the other team's expense.

TIPS for Core Values Judging

- Your team should be demonstrating Core Values in everything you do.
- Carefully plan how your team will “show” Core Values as part of your video presentations.
- The same rubric and judging process as in person events will be used.
- Do not talk over your teammates, take turns!
- Have Fun!

Gracious professionals lend a helping hand to an opponent when needed because they want everyone to have a chance to compete.
